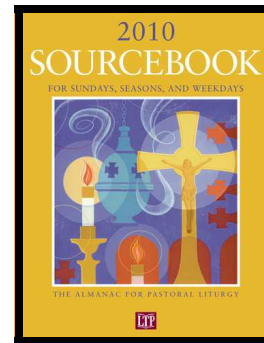
Directions: To St. Nicholas, Virginia Beach:
